Warehouse & Transportation

- Receiving of materials

- Ensure proper movement of materials FIFO

Production Planning

Material Planning

- Material planning (budget, FC,.....), ordering (disposition, purchase requisition) and monitoring of supply
- Support supplier management (provide data, info's on deliveries like supplier OTIF, quantities, quality/claims) to PUR (supplier development) and to Quality (Supplier Quality Management)
- Inventory planning and management RM incl. shelf-life, excess/obsolete materials
