- Read specifications, use hand tools, tape measures and other gauging devices to monitor current and ongoing product quality.
- React quickly to equipment downtime or other extraordinary condition, and must notify supervision whenever such conditions occur.
- Perform actions with a control panel interface, both automatic and manual
- Execute basic sequencing process on Tire Build machines
- Possess and apply problem solving skills in case of machine cycle issues
