This role will provide hands-on experience in ergonomics and workplace design, ideal for students or recent graduates with an interest in health and safety, industrial design, or human factors.

- Ergonomic Assessments: Assist in conducting workstation evaluations and ergonomic assessments for employees to identify potential risks and areas for improvement.
- Data Collection & Analysis: Gather and analyze data from ergonomic assessments, employee surveys, and workplace observations to generate insights for design improvements.
- Project Support: Help with the design, implementation, and evaluation of ergonomic interventions aimed at reducing musculoskeletal strain and improving overall workplace comfort.
- Workplace Observation: Conduct in-person walkthroughs of workspaces to observe and document current ergonomic conditions and identify opportunities for improvement.
