The Rework/Repair Operator is responsible for performing various tasks including repairing belts, setting up and operating equipment, inspecting, and ensuring nonconforming materials are properly handled. This role requires meticulous attention to detail, strict adherence to safety protocols, and a commitment to maintaining high-quality standards to ensure the final product quality meets the customer's specification.

- Inspection and repair of rubber belting products as possible to ensure fit/form/function and comply with customer expectations
- Set up and operate all equipment according to company procedures, standards, and work instructions.
- Follow all processing, measuring, packaging, and shipping procedures as directed.
- Comply with all safety rules and regulations and maintains a clean, organized and safe work environment
- Utilize the NCR as a quality metric and improvement tool
 - Assist in the closure of NCR's, and dispositions of repaired roles
 - Assist in determining nonconforming materials in quarantine
 - Follow up on Corrective Action submissions
- Perform inspections and audits on materials that potentially will or wont be repaired
 - Verify inspection report data and report accordingly any disposition or repair
 - Participate in the preparation of ISIR and PPAP documentation
- Participate in the examination, evaluation and disposition of warranty items and rejected materials
- May occasionally be required to reroll matrices as well as roll length verifications as secondary duties
- · Perform any other duties as assigned or required
