- Communication with production about changes, stoppages and problem solving.
- Reviewing with Material Planning team, raw material coverage and any potential problem areas.
- Production Planning Master data maintenance for current and new part numbers.
- Communication with engineering departments about changes for Cycle time and OEE, to incorporate into the production plan.
