- Responsible to prioritize improvement gaps and define improvement plans for productivity increase and cost/waste reduction, ensuring improvements out of deviation management.
- Reports savings out of the continuous improvement / lean activities, Collaborate with the Controlling team.
- Escalate issues that need higher management decision/ approval/ review (e.g. fluctuation, project issues, technical issues).
- Define and implements actions/ supervises the implementation of actions to minimize risks and measures the efficiency of the actions.
