Your tasks

Extrusion Rework Operator must be able to read specs, know all tire components used in Mixing, and follow safety and quality standards.

- Responsible for: operating machine, exchange of pallets, rubber containers, and trolleys, sequencing, control panel operations and recipe weight measurements.
- Responsible for: marking and identifying compounds, including special markings for Halobutyl, B460, and clean out compounds.
- Responsible for: Handling, transporting and storage of materials and compounds.
- Responsible for: batch release of rework compounds.
- Possess and apply problem solving skills in case of machine cycle issues.
- Read specifications, use hand tools, and gauging devices, to monitor current and ongoing product quality.
- React quickly to equipment downtime or other extraordinary conditions and must notify supervision whenever such conditions occur.
- Perform actions with a control panel interface, both automatic and manual.
- Must be able to read and understand written and oral instructions: as to specs, procedures, tolerances, and various construction and quality requirements.
- Communicate with other inbound and outbound operators, production operators, and supervisors.
- Follow all plant policies, environmental policies, and plant and departmental safety policies.
- Drives forklifts and operate other material handling equipment and is responsible for the proper care and safe operation of the material handling equipment.
- Performs other duties as directed by the shift leaders or management team.
- Demonstrate the characteristics of 5S Care and Inspect to keep work areas and machines neat, clean, aligned, orderly and maintained
