Your tasks

- 1. The Palletizer must know all OEM tire marking requirements and properly affix 2D sticker; High Point Sticker; Paint Dauber; crayon marking; spray adhesive, conicity tags, article number and Palletizer I.D.
- 2. The Palletizer will remove PLT Tires up to 45#'s from waist high conveyor and stacked from floor to shoulder high on a pallet at 200 tires per hour rate.
- 3. The Palletizer will occasionally use fork lifts when necessary. Must be certified to operate a Fork Lift through the Safety Department. Responsible for the proper care and safe operation of this material handling equipment.
- 4. The Palletizer will follow standard practices and perform all work necessary to promptly and accurately obtain quality and quantity production, and keeping work areas neat, clean, aligned and orderly.
- 5. The Palletizer will follow all plant policies, environmental policies, and plant and departmental safety policies.
- 6. The Palletizer must be able to communicate with other palletizers, warehouse truckers, PLT Final Finish Supervision and Department Manager.
- 7. Perform other duties as directed by the PLT Final Finish Supervisor or Department Manager.
