Composition, training, implementation and maintenance of documentation and machine control media of plant systems and equipment based upon upgrades, installations and task procedures.

- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to optimize system performance, assist in commissioning new projects, and standardize equipment components and vendor selections for cost efficiency and reliability.
- Provide technical documentation and mentorship – creating clear instructions, wiring schedules, and BOMs for Maintenance; pursue ongoing training and mentor maintenance personnel on engineering and automation practices.
- Uphold plant and corporate standards by maintaining compliance with all safety, government, and Continental policies; accurately log work in SAP/PUMA, maintain a clean and professional workspace, and be available for coverage or overtime as needed.
