- Sample and test mixed and calendered compounds per plant QMS requirements.
- Use hand tools and gauging devices to monitor product quality and ensure adherence to tolerances.
- React promptly to equipment issues and report extraordinary conditions to supervision.
- Maintain lab cleanliness following 5S principles and ensure lab compliance with CCC scope.
- Operate a forklift if required and move materials including die rheometers.
- Communicate effectively, follow instructions, and demonstrate strong computer and component knowledge.
