HOW YOU WILL MAKE AN IMPACT

Pick, pack, and prepare orders for shipment according to daily schedules and customer requirements

Accurately verify product quantities, descriptions, and shipping details before dispatch.

Operate warehouse equipment (e.g., pallet jacks, forklifts, scanners) safely and efficiently.

Ship all small parcel shipments.

Assist with receiving, unloading, and stocking incoming shipments as needed.

Repack materials for shipments.

Follow direction of the supervisor of the SMF (external) warehouse.

Report inventory discrepancies, damaged goods, or shipping issues to supervisors promptly.

Collaborate with warehouse and logistics teams to ensure timely and accurate order fulfillment.

You will be required to be able to operate a forklift proficiently and safely to load/unload trucks and to locate materials using a scanner.

You will be required to maintain a clean environment at all times by following good housekeeping practices.

Safety awareness in daily work to ensure a safe work environment at all times is a vital part of your role.

Act as an effective team member to communicate daily tasks and instructions.

The position requires use of Personal Protective Equipment which includes safety shoes, safety glasses, and hearing protection and other PPE as required for the various job duties.
