- Review and update **Job Safety Analysis (JSA's)** – (Primary)
- Perform **Environmental Daily, Weekly, and Monthly Inspections** to ensure compliance with internal policies and regulatory requirements.
- Maintain organization in the **OSS Room**, including marking, labeling, and managing drums according to waste streams.
