- Support Head of IT Hub Lousado and the CC Head with the preparation and follow-up of annual financial budget and monthly forecasts for the IT Hub and the CC overall;
- Implement personal development measures for the team in alignment with local HR, Head of IT-Hub Lousado, central team and external providers.
