Your tasks

1. Uniformity Clerk must be able to effectively communicate with supervision, other tire-room personnel, and any supplying department supervision.
2. Uniformity Clerk will follow all plant policies, environmental policies, and plant and departmental safety policies. Must be certified to operate a Forklift through the Safety Department.
3. Uniformity Clerk must be able to read gauging devices, read identification tags, tire codes, and possess good math skills to add and subtract both positive and negative numbers, must be able to write, collect, and enter data as required.
4. Uniformity Clerk must be knowledgeable of tire components, tire building machines, curing presses, tuos, and balancer.
5. Uniformity Clerk will follow standard practices and perform all work necessary to promptly and accurately obtain quality and quantity production, and keeping work areas neat, clean, and orderly.
6. Uniformity Clerk must be alert to of out-of-spec conditions or any extraordinary condition and immediately notify tire room supervision whenever such conditions occur.
7. Uniformity Clerk's time must be accurately and correctly indicated on timecard with proper account code.
8. Perform other duties as directed by the PLT Shift Supervisor or Department Manager
9. Uniformity Clerk is responsible for lifting tires varying in weight from 40 to 70 lbs.
