- Identify risks and opportunities related to demand variability, capacity constraints, and supply disruptions, proposing mitigation plans proactively.
- Act as a key interface between Supply Chain, Manufacturing, Commercial, and Logistics teams.
- Support continuous improvement initiatives in demand planning, supply planning, and S&OP processes.
- Prepare and present analysis, scenarios, and recommendations to the Demand & Supply Planning Manager and regional stakeholders.
- Take a leadership role in S&OP and S&OE process
