- Organize and monitor the production machinery planned maintenance process, its planning, fulfillment, documentation and continuous improvement (including inspections, lubrication, preventive and predictive maintenance tasks, Machine Tolerance Checks, big repairs) in the area of responsibility

- Identifies, analyses and insures the implementation of potential technical improvements on area production machineries in cooperation with other departments (Production, Quality, Purchasing)
- Lead several machine improvements, refurbishments, upgrades or installation project
- Environment, Safety, and Health (ESH): Promote and enforce ESH standards, ensure rapid response to hazards, and lead by example in safety practices.
