The **Color Development Intern** will gain hands-on experience in laboratory and production settings to optimize the current product portfolio within the Livtec Industry. With a focus on sustainability and continuous improvement, the Color Development Intern will work to incorporate scrap and recycled materials into formulations while maintaining quality performance standards. They will also investigate ways to optimize color matching in the production environment to reduce start up times associated to color matching.

Responsibilities include formula preparation at lab scale, material performance testing, and potential to scale lab formulations to production trials. They will participate in aspects of the development process and interface with other cross functional project groups, including, laboratories, engineering, and operations.
