- Provide distribution and shipping support for apparel and select marketing-related fulfillment activities, without ownership of planning.

- Perform tire adjustments as needed to support operations.
- Conduct monthly inspections of fire extinguishers and first aid kits; replenish supplies as required.

- Act as a backup Group Leader (GL), supporting team coordination, daily operations, and workflow continuity as needed.
