- Performs Root Cause Analysis on equipment failures. Develop and enact corrective actions.
- Assist with ensuring materials are available to facilitate planned maintenance activities.
- Support the Lean transformation at Marysville through providing maintenance support for Rapid Improvement Events and Lean projects.
