- Support process improvement projects related to materials, packaging, logistics, and supplier performance.
- Promote environmental, health, and safety standards within the laboratory.
- Utilize strong problem-solving, organizational, and communication skills.
- Be self-managed, detail-oriented, and capable of performing under pressure.
- Follow all plant, ESH, CBS, quality, and department processes and procedures.
